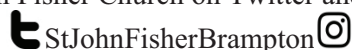
Although the Parish collections have ended, we **ShareLife** graciously accept your donations until July 31st.

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the ***Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ***. I had been preparing Catechumens who wish to be Catholics through a series of lectures about the Trinity, commandments, teachings of the Church, Eucharist and so on. I find one of the most difficult teachings to be the *real presence* of Christ in the Eucharist. It can never have a narrow focus and must always be understood as the source and summit of our faith. It is more than attending Mass and going forward in the Communion line. Instead, it is how we are changed when we receive and what we take forth from the Eucharistic celebration – being careful to focus on the communal action of the body of Christ.

As we gather at the table of the Eucharistic celebration, we take, look up and consume the broken bread we are given. In that communal action, we bring to life the body and blood of Christ. It doesn't stop there. Instead we are called to go forth to the multitudes and give what has been received. We received food to sustain us and there will always be enough to go around. The basket will always be full.

I would highly suggest that after you've received Communion, go back to your seat, and please kneel down for a while and thank Jesus who is right there in your heart and talk to him about the things that are needed to change in you.

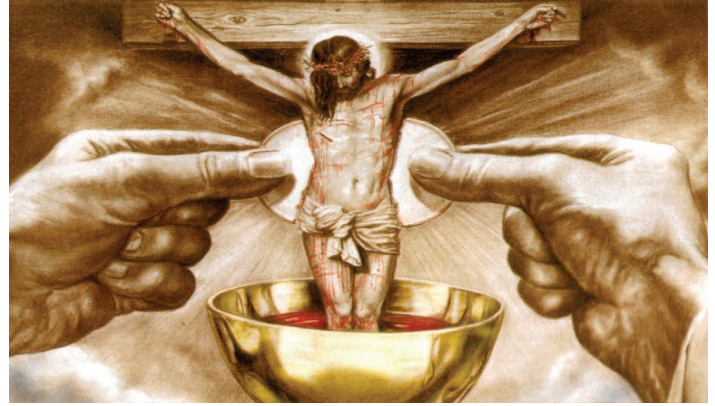
