Each service is about 8 minutes. ▶ First-come, first-served. Please bring your patience with you! If the session you hope to attend is full, we kindly ask you to

wait in your cars for the next available service.

Please use this time to pray and meditate on this year's challenges.



Dear Parishioners of St John Fisher Church:

This *Fourth Sunday of Easter* we are invited to contemplate the blessedness of being friends: friends of God, friends of Jesus, and friends of one another. Jesus says: "I no longer speak of you as slaves...instead I call you friends." We can call this: *Friendly Sunday*.

Being chosen means that another has taken the initiative and exercised a prerogative that singles me out, sets me apart and offers me a new identity- a friend. Jesus took this initiative and chose us to be His friend. To be friends with Jesus is a gift - unsolicited, unearned, unexpected.

William Barclay says: At the court of the Roman emperor there was a select group of men known as "the friends of the emperor." At all times, day or night, they had the right to enter the emperor's presence. No one else had such a right - no senator, no consul, no military commander. The emperor consulted "the friends" before he spoke with his statesmen or generals on any issue. "The friends of the emperor were those who had the closest and the most intimate connection with him."

This is the context in which Jesus spoke of his apostles as his friends. What does it mean to be a chosen friend of Jesus? To be a friend of Jesus has an obligation. He didn't say "Be my friend and you can do everything." Instead, Jesus says: "You are my friend if you keep my commandment." To be a friend of Jesus means that we are to keep his command and love one another as he has loved us. Friendship also has a responsibility. You cannot just do anything you want and remain a friend.

There was an ancient controversy that has become critical because it is polarizing the church into two groups.

- One group focuses on prayer and contemplation often referred to as vertical dimension.
- The other group advocates the social Gospel, the horizontal dimension, stressing service towards our brothers and sisters.

Jesus said: *This is my command that you love one another*. This is not an option. It is a command for us Christians. Friendship is not presumed among members of a family. We cannot be called a Christian family unless we are a family of friends.

We have a parent who responds to a baby's cry in the middle of the night. A nurse who gently bathes a bedsore patient. A teenager who willingly shovels the snow for an elderly neighbour. A retired person who volunteers to stuff envelops for charity mailing. An auto mechanic who repairs a traveler's car. These people have *laid down their lives, have died to self*.

In the middle of this pandemic let us exercise love and friendship with one another. Do whatever we can to alleviate the suffering of our fellow parishioners. Go the extra mile. Give a helping hand. Share encouraging words. "There is no greater love than this: to lay down one's life for a friend."
