FIRE PREVENTION MEASURES UPDATE

The Fire Alarm System is now completely installed! The total cost was \$26,766.31 (including HST).

- ① Fire Panel and Devices Replacement
- ② Fire Safety Plan
- ③ Fire Alarm System Annual Inspection
- ④ Emergency Lighting Annual Inspection
- ⑤ Fire Extinguishers Annual Inspection

Thanks to you, dear Parishioners, we have raised a total of \$24,312.72. Unfortunately, the Archdiocese takes 15% for the Diocesan Assessment so that means we have only paid off \$20,665.81. We still need to raise about \$7,500 to account for the 15% Diocesan Assessment that will be taken.

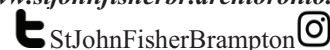

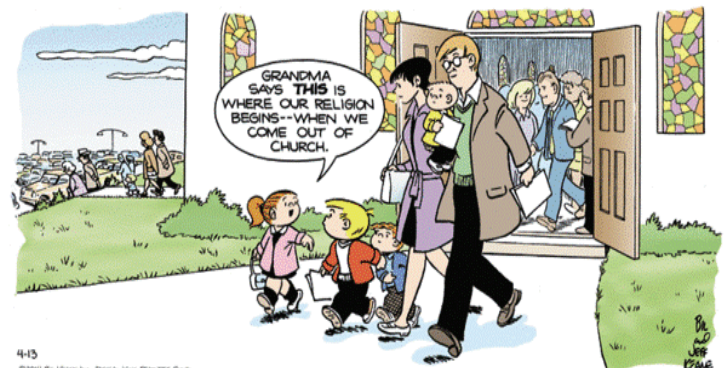

Training will be provided for all roles. Why not try something new? Please consider using the talents God has given you.

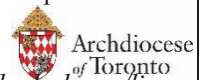

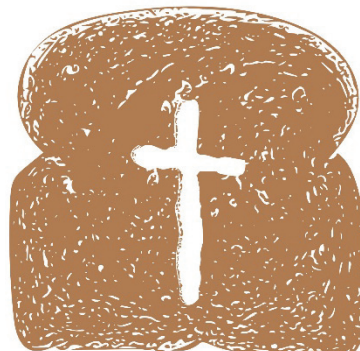
- 1 You can give cash or FreshCo/No Frills gift cards (\$20/\$30/\$50). Place your contributions into the blue collection boxes.
