The Fire Alarm System is now completely installed! The total cost was \$26,766.31 (including HST).

- Fire Panel and Devices Replacement
- Pire Safety Plan S Fire Alarm System Annual Inspection
- Emergency Lighting Annual Inspection
- **9** Fire Extinguishers Annual Inspection
