FIRE PREVENTION MEASURES UPDATE

The Fire Alarm System is now completely installed!
The total cost was \$26,766.31 (including HST).

- ❶ Fire Panel and Devices Replacement
- ❷ Fire Safety Plan
- ❸ Fire Alarm System Annual Inspection
- ❹ Emergency Lighting Annual Inspection
- ❺ Fire Extinguishers Annual Inspection

Thanks to you, dear Parishioners, we have raised a total of \$26,655.72. Unfortunately, the Archdiocese takes 15% for the Diocesan Assessment so that means we have only paid off \$22,657.36. We still need to raise about **\$5,157** to account for the 15% Diocesan Assessment that will be taken.

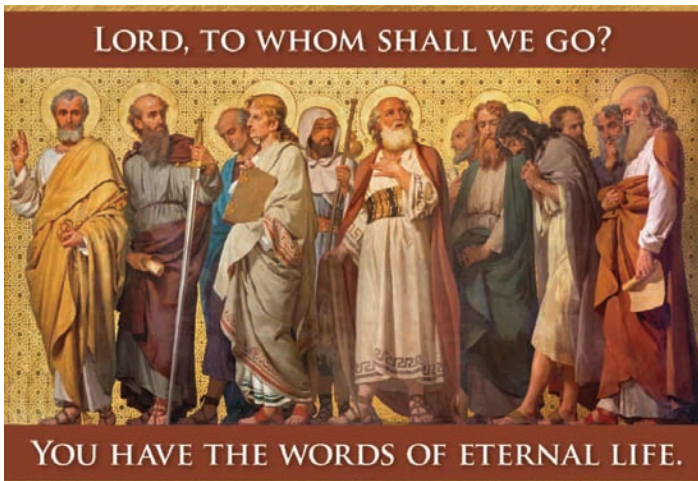

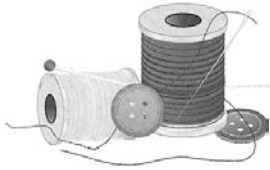
