**FIRE PREVENTION MEASURES UPDATE**

The Fire Alarm System is now completely installed! The total cost was \$26,766.31 (including HST).

- ❶ Fire Panel and Devices Replacement
- ❷ Fire Safety Plan
- ❸ Fire Alarm System Annual Inspection
- ❹ Emergency Lighting Annual Inspection
- ❺ Fire Extinguishers Annual Inspection

Thanks to you, dear Parishioners, we have raised a total of \$27,455.72. Unfortunately, the Archdiocese takes 15% for the Diocesan Assessment so that means we have only paid off \$23,357.36. We still need to raise about **\$4,045** to account for the 15% Diocesan Assessment that will be taken.

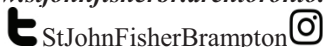

- **Sacristans** prepare the altar for mass and tidy up after. Leave a message for Silvana at (905) 793-6997.

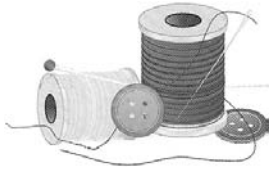
- **Eucharistic Ministers** distribute communion during mass. Leave a message for Fred at (905) 793-7360.
