Dear Parishioners:

Greetings of Peace!

Let us be honest. We live in an age when many feel that marriage is under attack and many young people no longer embrace marriage although they live as a couple.

First, we must admit that *“marriage is made in heaven”*. This means that marriage was established by God and that He is the only authority to make rules on marriage. Marriage is not the Church's creation, neither is it established by the government. It is fundamentally God's work. So, it is God who has set the rules. God's original intent was togetherness of man and woman.

Jesus did not offer an opinion of his own. He made no explanation. Instead, Jesus drew the attention of his questioners back to the very reason for which God's gift of marriage was intended. But from the beginning of creation, *“God made them male and female. For this reason, a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become flesh. So, they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore, what God had joined together let no one separate.”* Jesus makes it clear that this is still God's plan. One man, one woman, together and faithful forever.

By bringing us back to the origin of marriage, it shows us the very reason of establishing marriage. Having created man, God announced that it wasn't good for man to be alone. Thus, the emergence of woman. The man could not be complete without the woman. The woman is also God's free creation, and the two creatures of surprises belong together. They are one! God did not allow that he would create a woman from another substance but from the same substance and nature as man. It affirms the equality between the partners. To create a woman God did not take a substance from his foot or head but from the rib - the section of the heart. The importance and value of the woman was acknowledged by man through his own lips: *“This is indeed, the bone of my bone, the flesh of my flesh.”*

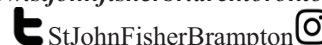

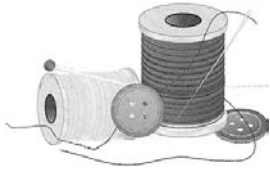
