Dear Parishioners:

In the middle of a city stood a medium-sized church with a big board:

LITE CHURCH: 24 percent fewer commitments, home of the 7.5 percent tithe; 7-minute sermon; 35-minute worship service. We have only 7 Commandments - your choice. Everything you've always wanted in a church - and less!

We have heard this gospel of the Great Commandment many times. After having heard it all these years in church, is there anything new or different to say about it? NO! But the Church wants us to hear it over and over again.

"Hear, O Israel! The Lord our God is Lord alone! Therefore, you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength." And Jesus goes on to say, "This is the second, 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.""

These two quotations from Deuteronomy and Leviticus are put side by side. They are intertwined; they are interlocked. They are so interrelated that one is not valid without the other. The heritage we have from the gospel is that the love of God and the love of neighbour are inseparable dimensions of a life of faith. One author calls it the *"theme of double love"*.

What is new with this commandment? You will recall that the farewell discourse of Jesus with his disciples at the last supper is: "I give you a new commandment, love one another as I have loved you." This is the new commandment. The old commandment was "Love your neighbour as you love yourself." We can no longer be content to love our neighbours as we love ourselves. It is no longer sufficient to "do unto others, as you would have them do unto you." No, the new commandment requires you to love one another in his word **'as I have loved you'**.
