Dear People of God:

Today we begin *Ordinary Time*. The color is green. But Ordinary Time doesn't mean unimportant. It doesn't mean dullness and boredom. It means discovering God in the everyday-ness of life. The wedding that happened in Cana, is part of our ordinary life event.

Today's Cana story by John the Evangelist is filled with deeper meanings and symbols. It wasn't just the wedding of a man and woman. The wedding at Cana is a symbol of a new marriage between God - Jesus, the bridegroom, and the new people of God. Who are the new people of God? New people of God are all those who believe that Jesus is God and Saviour sent by the Father. They are all Christians: Catholics, Protestants, Anglicans, Presbyterians, United, Baptists, Episcopalian, and other Christian denominations. The problem is they are not united. There are differences in belief. They are not comfortable with one another.

From January 18th – 25th, we celebrate the *Week of Prayer for Christian Unity*. The unity of Christians was the prayer Jesus said at the end of his earthly life: "I ask not only on behalf of these but also on behalf of those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one. As you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us..." (Jn 17:20)

The prayer of Jesus is also our prayer, and the will of Jesus is also our will. Prayer for Unity is an essential mission of the Church. It is not an extra activity; it is part of our activity as the church. You are all invited, "we are witnesses". The Eucharist is the Sacrament of Unity. We pray that all Christians will one day share with us the Eucharist at His table. We are all witnesses of what the Eucharist has done and will do for us as new people of God.
