



Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday we celebrate the *6th Sunday in Ordinary Time*. The Gospel brings us Luke's version of the Beatitudes. Rather than eight beatitudes, he has four blessings and four woes, again highlighting the choices we all have to make. "*Blessed are you who are poor*" and "*Woe to you who are rich*."

Jesus is looking up at the people of the world, including us, Christians who hold citizenship in one of the wealthiest countries of the world. This is a tough challenge for us. When we survey our abundance and recognize what we count on for security, it is very troubling to hear, "You have received your consolation."

Luke wrote his Gospel for a community like ours, people who lived in an economically and socially unequal society. He demonstrated how Jesus consistently stood with the poor and marginalized. Jesus' special concern for the poor, the marginal and the sinner is a central feature in Luke's unique parables of the good Samaritan, the prodigal son, and the widow and the unjust judge. Jesus advised his wealthy contemporaries to be sure that their banquets were frequented by the poor, blind, crippled, and lame.

A big challenge for all of us who live in an affluent country is: Where do we put our trust, our hope and security? Most people would put their trust and security on money and investments, fortune, and good paying jobs. What if the things that we rely on are taken away from us? But the poor who have nothing to rely on, would certainly place their trust, hope and security in the Lord. Blessed are they.

We have many individuals in our churches who are living on their own in very fragile health and NEED OUR HELP. My vocational call as a Parish Nurse, since 2003, has been to try to assist these individuals and their families to obtain the Circle of Support they need.

I urgently need the assistance of two personal attendants to assist an 86-year-old female with her *Activities of Daily Living* for 3-5 hours per day. These individuals must have current CPR and First Aid and at least one must have a current or pending healthcare registration. Salary is to be negotiated. 
