



Dear Friends/People of God:

Our society today is bombarded with world and local news about violence, revenge, and hatred. A recent example is the conflict between Ukraine and Russia. Reports say that 14,000 lives have been lost in the ongoing conflict in eastern Ukraine.

The church today is giving us a different kind of story: the Old Testament story about King Saul who had made several unsuccessful attempts on David's life. Nevertheless, David did not take advantage of the fact that the sleeping Saul was within his grasp. He could easily stab Saul to death. David did not do so. Rather than retaliate, he chose to respect the king and spare his life because he knew that Saul was also God's anointed.

Then, we move from David to Jesus and from Judaism to Christianity. Jesus came and entered the world of violence and hatred and un-love. Revenge/retaliation seemed to be the trend during his time. Violence was confronted with violence, hatred with hatred, evil with another evil.

If violence creates violence and more violence, then it creates a vicious circle of an unending succession of evil. How could He bring about the Rule of God among these people? How could they put an end to this cycle?

Jesus says: "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you; bless those who curse you, pray for those who maltreat you...turn your cheek...give to all who beg...expect no repayment." This is a positive challenge: "Do to others what you would have them do to you."
