

All Fridays within the Season of Lent, there will be NO Morning Mass. At 7 pm there will be the WAY OF THE CROSS followed by Mass.



PARISH LENTEN CELEBRATION OF CONFESSION

Canon #1457: According to the Church's command, "after having attained the age of discretion each of the faithful is found by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year. Anyone who is aware of having committed a mortal sin must not receive Holy Communion without having first received sacramental absolution. Children must go to the sacrament of Confession before receiving Holy Communion for the first time."

To comply with this sacred obligation, the parish has designated Thursday, April 7th as our Day of Confession.

Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday is the *4th Sunday of Lent*. The Gospel is about the parable of the prodigal son. You have heard the story so many times you could probably tell it by heart. What you have forgotten, though, is the context of the story.

Let us listen to this story again in a very prayerful manner and ask God to give us a new insight. I hope my own reflection can be of good help for your consideration. The story begins with Jesus' words: "A man had two sons." They were as different as night and day. The younger son had run away, blew all his inheritance, and acted totally irresponsibly. The older son stayed home, budgeted his money, and did all that was asked of him. Despite their differences, they shared the same father. Though poles apart in personalities, they could not escape the fact that they were brothers. They were family. "A man had two sons."

The tax collectors and sinners whom the Pharisees and the scribes were complaining about are the people with whom Jesus would hang out often. They had negative stereotypes of sinners and tax collectors and mingling with them would attract this description: *They were "one of them"*.

Now think of someone who is different from you. Someone that you, like the Pharisees, complain about. Different racial background, gay & straight, rich & poor, homeless & people on welfare, undocumented immigrants & legal citizens. Yes, we are different from one another, but the parable is telling us "We are brothers and sisters." We are prodigal sons and daughters, yet our Father in heaven loves us and is always ready to forgive. God the Father takes good care of us and is always ready to give good things for our welfare. Like the prodigal son, let us acknowledge our sins and go back to the loving embrace of the Father.


