Dear Parishioners:


This week our Pope is asking the whole Catholic World to help him financially to perform his charitable duty to the poor of the world. How does God's love abide in anyone who has the world's goods, and sees a brother or sister in need and yet refuses help? (1John 3:17)

When the earliest disciples of Jesus set out to change the world, they did so with the awareness that they themselves must first be changed. That change from within their hearts and minds; hence they will be able to change the hearts of others through the power of the Holy Spirit. The transforming power of the Holy Spirit enabled the first followers of Jesus to change their minds and hearts, that is from within.

When you go home, I would like you to look in the mirror and describe what you see. Today, Jesus asks us to recognize him in ourselves: "...you will see me because I live and you will live...you are in me and I in you." How many of us look in the mirror and really see Jesus? Why does it make us uncomfortable? Is it easier to see Jesus in a homeless man on the street corner? In a priest? In a missionary? What are the consequences of seeing Jesus in us? It may be an image that is difficult to live up to, but one that is real.


