Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the *Thirty-Second Sunday in* Ordinary Time. The Sadducees did not accept resurrection in the afterlife. They tried to get Jesus to say that there was no resurrection because this woman would have seven husbands and that was against the law and couldn't be allowed by God in the afterlife. The Sadducees' argument *"rest upon a crass assumption that life after death would"* simply be a repetition or extension of life in the present time," according to Brendan Byrne.

In his response, Jesus gives an insight into what resurrected life is about. It is not about giving and taking in marriage. It is not about dying. It is not about repetition. Resurrected life is about "being alive." Abraham, Isaac and Jacob had all gone before. But God is their God even now. God is their God in this life and in the life to come. "God is not God of the dead but of the living, for to Him all are alive." Those who are risen to life in God live as a totally new creation. There is no need for marriage. Marriage is an earthly sacrament with lots of cultural rules and requirements. In heaven, there is only God's love for every individual. And there you have it – the rest of the story.

Jesus said: "I AM THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE ... "


