Dear Parishioners

Today is the **Second Sunday of Easter**. John the Evangelist starts his story this way: "on the evening of the first day of the week..." John is now operating in a new time zone. According to the Jewish reckoning, a day began with sunset, a concept that goes back to Genesis 1, which counted the days saying, "Evening came and morning followed, the first day..." When John calls the evening of the day of Christ's resurrection the "first day," he is speaking about the first day of the new creation, a symbolic day that will never end.

The news of the resurrection spread among the disciples. Jesus made himself present in the midst of the disciples who were hiding in the upper room. Now, on this first day of the new creation, just as the Creator had blown the breath of life into Adam, Jesus breathed his own Spirit over them and asked them to receive it. Those who received Jesus' Spirit and peace received the power to carry on his mission of forgiveness. Forgiveness brings people into union with God and one another. This is why St Pope John Paul II designated this Sunday as "Divine Mercy Sunday."

Thus, he introduced us to Thomas, the twin brother of everyone who was absent on the first night. For those of us who do not believe because they have not seen and touched the risen Jesus, this word of Jesus is for us:

"BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO HAVE NOT SEEN AND HAVE BELIEVED."
