Dear Parishioners:

Greetings of Peace!

Today we celebrate the feast of the *Most Holy Trinity*. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church #234, "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life." All of that is declared every time we sign ourselves, saying "In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit."

The well-known story of Saint Augustine runs this way: One day while walking along the seashore, pondering the Trinity, Augustine encountered a boy pouring ocean water into a hole in the sand. The boy explained: "I am going to put the entire ocean into this hole." Saint Augustine told him that it was impossible. The hole in the sand was too small to contain all of the vast ocean. Surprisingly the boy replied, "And neither can you fit the Trinity into your little brain."

God is totally, absolutely Mystery. And that does not mean simply mysterious or vague, something that is not yet known but will become clear. No. Mystery means, by definition, essentially unknowable. Even when we are in heaven, face to face with God in the Beatific Vision, God will remain Holy Mystery. But we won't mind because then we will appreciate just what Holy Mystery is.


