Beloved Parishioners:

This Sunday we celebrate the *31st Sunday in Ordinary* Time. During the time of Jesus, He condemned the Scribes, Pharisees, and religious leaders of Israel for not practicing what they preach. They perform holy things for a show. They want to have the best seats in banquets and synagogues. They want people to call them "Rabbi".

Jesus exposes the hypocrisy and vanity of the Scribes and Pharisees saying, "Everything they do is done for attention...Do not be guided by what they do since they do not practice what they preach."

As a leader, Jesus did not concern himself with symbols or titles. He had no social status, no seat of honor; he was not wealthy, nor was he famous; we do not even know what he looked like. His gestures, his talk, his gaze flowed from his being. They were neither practiced nor acquired. He was not a trained orator. He spoke from the heart. He spoke the truth with conviction, without calculating its effects.

Jesus is addressing us with His words: church leaders; ministry leaders; lectors, Eucharistic ministers, choir members, ushers, altar servers, church volunteers, parents and guardians; grandparents and Catholic teachers. Our actions should be consistent with our belief.

We are all called to a life of holiness, not only those in leadership positions. It is not just the "job" of priests, ministers, and religious leaders to be holy. The call from Jesus to live a new kind of life extends to everyone.




FIRST COMMUNION (GRADE 2) AND CONFIRMATION (GRADE 7) REGISTRATION FORMS are now




