Dear Parishioners:

A Good Advent will result in a Good and Joyful Christmas. On this *Third Sunday of Advent*, we have arrived to Gaudete Sunday. We are reminded that the joy of Christmas is not far away. The joy of Christmas is how we make it. Like our ancestors, we yearn for peace and justice, healing and restoration.

It wouldn't be a surprise, though, if many people were having a difficult time finding joy in our world these days. With continuing corruption and disruption in governments around the world; with increasing effects of climate change bringing death and destruction across the globe; with wars and killing etc., it may be hard to feel any real joy. We should look within our own hearts. If our own hearts are not ready to love, forgive and share and change for the better, it may be hard to feel any real joy.


