To the People of God at St John Fisher Parish:

GREETINGS OF PEACE AND JOY!

The shepherds said to one another, "Let us go now to Bethlehem and see this thing that has taken place, which the Lord has made known to us."

Jesus left his home in heaven and became like us, adopting himself to our ordinary human situation. Surprisingly enough, on the day he was born of Mary, his Mother, he allowed himself to be revealed first to the poor shepherds.

To understand completely and deeply the story of Christmas, one has to adopt the lowliness, humility and dependency of the shepherds. There was no knowledge of what happened to the shepherds who first visited the baby Jesus. I would presume that something amazing had happened to their personal lives or that of their families on a spiritual level, and who knows, maybe it did translate into some material sufficiency. "For nothing will be impossible with God," says the Angel Gabriel.

The story of Christmas speaks to us again of new birth and the possibility of our own rebirth. It tells us that things can be different. To quote a patristic cliche, "GOD BECAME HUMAN THAT WE MIGHT BECOME DIVINE."

Jesus is Emmanuel: God-with-us. How lovely is God's dwelling indeed! God dwells with us here and now in our parish community, in our homes, in our schools, in our neighbourhood.
