Today is the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the Gospel,



Jesus cured Peter's mother-in-law. The late Cardinal Sin of Manila, Philippines once asked a group of his priests while dining: "Do you know why Peter denied the Lord three times?" Nobody could come up with an answer. The Cardinal himself answered: "Because Jesus cured his mother-in-law."

Simon's mother-in-law, whose name is not given to us, comes across as a woman of humble character. After Jesus cures her of her fever, she responds not with a simple act of thanksgiving but with gracious and loving service she rendered to Jesus and his disciples.

The first chapter of Mark tells us short stories about the ministry of Jesus. His hectic schedule of preaching, teaching, healing and praying. During that time, it seemed that the power of evil had the upper hand. The Gospel started with the salvific actions of Jesus against the evil of Satan. Yes, Satan is mighty, but Jesus is even more so. Yes, the world is filled with demonic forces, but Jesus has triumphed over all of them.

The first days of Jesus was composed of the healing of Peter's mother-in-law and then the healing of the demoniac. These events created a great scenario: When the Sabbath ended at sunset and Jesus opened the door, the whole town was waiting for him. They were bandaged and broken, exhausted and fed-up, and wanted to be healed. People are all in need of healing.

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace has released a Pastoral Letter on the use of social media entitled: "Let Your Speech Always Be Gracious." The release of the letter on January 24th was timed to coincide with the liturgical memorial of Saint Francis de Sales, who is invoked as a patron saint of writers, publishers and those working in the field of communications. Acknowledging the prominent role social media has come to play at an individual and societal level, this timely document considers the benefits and dangers of social media from the perspective of Catholic Social Teaching. It provides tools for moral reflection and self-examination, and suggests seven commitments by which to be guided for a more ethical use of social media: **1** check for accuracy 2 seek greater perspective 3 value human dignity 4 bring curiosity into the conversation **5** distinguish between intention and impact **6** privilege "in real life" encounters **7** tend to our time spent online. The letter, which may be of particular interest to those working in youth/young adult ministry, is available in electronic format and can be downloaded from the CCCB website.
