Beloved Parishioners:

This Sunday is the **Second Sunday of Lent**. Every now and then, we see someone whose face appears radiant. People speak of brides and grooms as glowing with joy. That kind of glow is far more than a smile of pleasure. It is even more than joy. It might appear when parents first behold their child, or see that child accomplish something wonderful. We seem to glow in moments of genuine fulfilment and love. That is what the disciples saw happen to Jesus as he prayed on the mountain.

Jesus entered into communion with his Father. He offered himself to and was wholly received by his Father. That experience so filled him that his face took on the look of grace and his entire being glowed. This is called Transfiguration.

This is the power of prayer. This is the power of our communion with God. Today's Gospel of Transfiguration reminds us that the covenant means transformation. We are called to grow ever deeper in our relationship with God, being transformed into the image of Christ Jesus.

In Lent, we enter into a journey of conversion. Through prayer, almsgiving, and fasting, we prepare our hearts to encounter the Lord. Through this frequent encounter with God using these Lenten exercises, we will be transformed into a new creation like the resurrected Jesus on Easter Sunday.

Let us continue our Lenten journey with joy!

FIRST COMMUNION CORNER: Classes will begin in the parish hall on Sunday, March 3rd for First Communion candidates. Students will be divided into 2 groups. Group A attends from

1-2 pm and Group B attends from 2:30-3:30 pm. *Attendance is mandatory for all 5 classes. There will be no make-up classes.* All families and First Communion students must attend the 12 pm mass on March 3rd for a short ceremony.

Ceremony dates for First Communion & Confirmation will be announced AFTER Easter.

CONFIRMATION UPDATES

The Enrolment Ceremony for Confirmandi is this weekend (February 24/25) at all masses. Families attend their usual mass and will receive

the copy of the rite at the entrance. The Confirmation candidate will prepare a hand-written (or typed) letter on a decent piece of paper, addressed to the Pastor, explaining why they want to receive this sacrament. In the middle of Mass, the priest will call the candidates to present their letter to the priest and receive the Blessed Wooden Cross to wear every day.

Classes: 9-10:25 am & Mass at 10:30 am March 3, 24, April 7, 21, 28, May 5

An important consideration: In order to be confirmed, candidates must complete all 6 sessions. By not doing so, we presume that the candidate is not fully ready for the reception of the Sacrament and perhaps, receiving this sacrament in the future is a better option.

Please bring the \$20 fee (per candidate) to the first session. Students will need a pen/pencil/eraser each week. The textbook will be provided.
