Beloved Parishioners:

As we celebrate the *Fourth Sunday of Lent*, we hear these comforting words of John: "For God so loved the world that he gave His only-begotten Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish by may have eternal life." God would do everything in order to save us from eternal death.

"As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Man of Heaven be lifted up that whoever believes in him may have eternal life." Jesus has to be lifted up. Lifted up has double meanings. First, Jesus is to be hoisted onto the gibbet of the cross; Second, he shall be resurrected from death and be exalted in glory at God's right hand.

Evangelist John has these consoling words: Those who would look with faith upon the cross of Christ would be healed of sin and delivered from death to enjoy eternal life.

The Cross, therefore, sends a powerful message. It shows us the extent of God's love for us. God loves us so much that he takes the initiative to reconcile us to himself.


