

Beloved People of God:

This Sunday we are invited to contemplate the blessedness of being friends, friends of God, friends of Jesus, and friends of one another. Jesus says: "I no longer speak of you as slaves...instead I call you friends."

William Barclay says: At the court of the Roman emperor there was a select group of men known as the friends of the emperor. At all times, day or night, they had the right to enter the emperor's presence. No one else had such a right - no senator, no consul, no military commander. The emperor consulted the friends before he spoke with his statesmen or generals on any issue. "The friends of the emperor were those who had the closest and the most intimate connection with him."



Sunday, May 5th is MENTAL HEALTH IN THE FAITH **COMMUNITIES AWARENESS SUNDAY.** Catholics throughout the Archdiocese are encouraged to participate in this day that raises awareness in our parish communities of the importance of mental health, how we need to look after it and how important it is to get help if we are struggling.
