Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the *Feast of the Solemnity of the* Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

The feeding of thousands of people by Jesus with five loaves and two fish was narrated by the four evangelists. And here is the touching story in the gospel: A multitude of people were following Jesus everywhere, even in deserted places, to listen to him. They wanted to experience for themselves the many miracles done by him. "When he went ashore, he saw a great crowd...he had compassion for them...When it was evening, Jesus said to them, 'They need not go away, you give them something to eat."

Many or most people are spiritually starving, though sometimes they don't realize it or do not know what to do. In the Gospel, Jesus shows us how much he cares when he said to his disciples: "You give them something to eat." I believe, and I hope you do too, that the Corpus Christi is Jesus' generous response. "Take and eat. Take and drink." He says this to us who are spiritually starving and whose spirit is getting low.

God knows what we need even before we ask. The Eucharist isn't abstract, a theological instruction, a creed, a moral precept, a philosophy, or even just an intimate word. It's a food and nourishment for body and spirit. "Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb."


