Beloved People of God:

"You are out of your mind!" Has anybody ever said that to you? Or you to another person? No doubt most of us have heard or said this a time or two.

Jesus' family comes to the conclusion that he's gone crazy. Their evidence? He gained fame as an exorcist who will touch women; he lays hand on lepers; eats with sinners; disregards pious fasting practices and violates Sabbath restrictions, etc. For them he is not the normal son of Joseph and Mary.

At the very least, this extraordinary behaviour put Jesus in danger and reflected very poorly on his kin. And for the authorities, this behaviour caused them to say: "He is possessed by Beelzebul."

Our religion is counter-cultural. Our values are different from the world's values. They call us many names - we are out of this world, weird, irrelevant, backwards, etc. If the "you are out of your mind" comment is directed at us, we are in good company according to today's Gospel. Our behaviour and moral compass, in the mind of secular people, is "politically incorrect".


