

Beloved Parishioners:

The seed that was planted by the farmer, according to the Gospel, is primarily under the watchful care of God. The kingdom will grow and develop "without our knowing how it happens" and regardless of all obstacles. The reign of God will flourish and grow, because God is a faithful and fastidious caretaker.

Jesus' parable of the seed begins by comparing natural growth with the growth of the church. It all started from a small beginning: the son of a carpenter and a handful of humble fishermen. It has gradually grown by the thousands and by the millions and by the hundred million. And it will continue to grow. Like a big mustard tree, it will be a haven for all kinds of people to find shelter.

Some 58 years ago, the seed of St John Fisher Parish was planted. The seed of the word was constantly being scattered every time the Eucharist was being celebrated. The seed grows by itself. The nourishment is always available through the sacraments and, most especially, the Eucharist.

What happens next? There will be some result but probably not in the way we want or when we want. Growth is a slow process. Let's be patient and allow God's action to take its course. Remember these words from St Mother Teresa: "We are not expected to succeed; but we are expected to be faithful."


