My elementary and high school years were in the Public System in the Brampton area. I attended two years of Drafting at Sheridan College and received my undergraduate degree in Religious Studies at York University.

In 1987, I entered St. Augustine's Seminary in Scarborough and was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Toronto in 1992. My first placement as a priest was at St. Peter's church in Woodbridge as an associate (1992 – 1995). I then moved to S. Salvador do Mundo/ Cristo Rei in Mississauga as an Associate (1995 – 1998). In 1998, I was named pastor of St. Elizabeth Seton in Newmarket and remained there until 2004. In 2004. Cardinal Ambrozic asked me to take on the roles of Vocations Director for the Archdiocese and Rector of Serra House in Toronto. I remained in this role until June 2009 and was given a six-month sabbatical. In January 2010, I was named pastor of St. Mary's parish here in Brampton until this past June.

I now have the great pleasure and honour to be your pastor! How long will this be? Only God and the Archbishop can know.

Please pray for me that I might be a good and holy Pastor for you and for the glory of God.
