Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses:


We will not have any Mass intentions. Fr Liborio will celebrate these Masses for all the intentions of the parishioners of St John Fisher.

Two dates are available. Please attend the date and time that works best for your family.



As you know, I have not been feeling myself lately. I was blessed to have Msgr Greg Ace help me this past weekend with two of our three Sunday Masses. As I write this Pastor's Corner on Tuesday, I am still not fully myself. I am still feeling weak and without energy.

This past Sunday I went to the Urgent Care hospital (the old Brampton civic Hospital) and saw a doctor who checked my vitals and thank God, all was basically normal. The doctor did say that I may be feeling unwell due to the lingering effects of the flu/virus I had about two weeks ago, where, as you may recall, I lost my voice. The doctor also said that the sudden death of my brother and other events in my life may have added to my feeling unwell.

I share this with you because we all need to take care of ourselves and our loved ones. I know of people who are unwell and refuse to get help. We need to remember that God has given us medical leaders who can help us be the best we can be to do the ministry of God through our words and actions. Getting ill can hit us at any time and it is humbling to seek help. We can get ill physically. But it's not just physical illnesses we can undergo - mental illness, stress, anxiety, grief and other symptoms can also hit us and these can be very debilitating.

I encourage you to always be true to yourselves and take care of your health. Don't allow the sense of embarrassment or weakness stop you in seeking help.

I pray that I will be back to my normal self very soon and in the meantime, I ask for your continued prayers.




IN THEATRES NOW: THE FORGE:


