 Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, For the last two weekends I have ors' offered in my Pastor's corner an article entitled "Sacramentals: What are

they?" by Regina Doman. I hope that you enjoyed the article as much as I did and pushed you to reflect on how you are using sacramentals in your life.

I encourage you all to consider having sacramentals as part of your daily life – be it the rosary you carry and say, a rosary or cross hanging from your car's rear-view mirror, having a holy water container in your homes for you to bless yourself as you come and go in your daily activities, having a cross prominently hung in your home, etc.

But the one thing I will suggest for your consideration is to have a "prayer corner" or a "sacred space" that family members can use when they wish. In this prayer corner or sacred space, you can put a Catholic bible, a statue of Jesus and Mary (and your favourite saints), and some holy water. This space can be a special place for family members to connect with God in silence. I encourage you to create this space in your home. Pray to the Lord and ask Him to tell you in your hearts where this space should be located.

May God continue to keep you in his tender care.
