 Dear Brother & Sisters in Christ, I'm pleased to announce that Pas ors' Deacon John Coletti has been assigned to minister at our Parish commencing next

weekend. He will also be our homilist next weekend, and will give you all a break from hearing me all the time.

Here is a little bio on our new Permanent Deacon John Coletti:

Deacon John was born in Toronto, to Italian immigrants, Loreto and Maria Coletti, and has one sibling, Renato Coletti. He was baptized at St Agnes Church and grew up in Little Italy attending St Francis of Assisi Church, St Francis of Assisi Elementary School, and Brother Edmund Rice High School.

Deacon John attributes his strong faith and devotion to our Blessed Mother and the Saints to his mother, Maria. At a young age he began serving the Church with a strong calling to join the Franciscan Order at the age of 18. However, with a strong desire to also get married and have a family he was advised by his Franciscan Pastor, Fr Angelo, that he can get married, have a family and become a Permanent Deacon later in life. Entrusting everything to our Blessed Mother, Deacon John was blessed to meet Serina in 1989 and married in September 1992. The couple has been blessed with two wonderful girls, Leanna & Teresa.

Over the years he would consider answering the call to the Diaconate, but it wasn't until 2010, at the age of 46, while looking at the Divine Mercy painting at St Joseph's Parish in Streetsville, that he heard the inner voice say, "it's time to answer the call". After five years in the Diaconate Formation Program at St Augustine Seminary, he was ordained a Permanent Deacon in May 2016.

He was assigned to Saint Francis Xavier Parish in Mississauga, and was there for six years until being assigned to St Mary Star of the Sea in Port Credit in July 2022. Deacon John and Serina have been Mentors in the Permanent Diaconate Program since 2016. Deacon John also serves as the Liturgist for the Diaconate Program at St Augustine Seminary. He's also a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 12067 and for the last two years was the Spiritual Director for the Saint Andre Bassett Fourth Degree Assembly. Deacon John was previously the Liaison to his Eminence Cardinal Collins, for the Catholic Charismatic Renewal Council for the Archdiocese of Toronto (CCRC) and in July 2023 was appointed, by Archbishop Leo, as Spiritual Director for the CCRC. Deacon John has recently been accepted as a Third Order Secular Franciscan at St Peter's Parish in Woodbridge and is truly humbled by the acceptance.

Finally, Deacon John is honoured to be assigned to serve at our Parish and is looking forward to meeting you all. Let us keep Deacon John and his family in our prayers, that the Lord may give him the words he will share with us and therefore lead us closer to the Love and Will of the Lord.
