For the sick. Contact the Rectory.



Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ, On this second Sunday of Advent, the **Pas** ors' Gospel focuses on the figure of John the Baptist.

At one point in the Gospel (not the one we read this Sunday), Jesus is asked to comment on his cousin, John. Jesus answers with these thought-provoking words, "Truly I tell you, among those born of women no one has arisen greater than John the Baptist ... "What made Jesus say these profound words and why would John be considered the most important person to have ever been born? The answer is found in what John does to prepare the way of the Lord. John's whole life was directed to identify the ONE.

In the movie "The Matrix" the storyline revolves around the search for the ONE who will be able to bring freedom to those who are captive in the machine world. The person who first identifies the ONE (Neo) is the character, Morpheus. Morpheus points him out and believes to his core that Neo is the ONE for whom they have been waiting.

If we were to use this movie as our guide, we would say that John the Baptist is Morpheus and Jesus is Neo. Like Morpheus, John points to the ONE at the river Jordan because he believes that Jesus is the ONE with all his being. He believes it to the point of losing his head at the hands of Herod.

John the Baptist is a critical figure in Salvation History because he shines a spotlight on Jesus and directs his followers to follow Jesus who is the ONE, and for whom John is "not worthy to untie the thong of his Sandals." Let us also follow the ONE every day and thank John the Baptist for pointing him out when he came 2,000 years ago.
