Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ, On this Fourth Sunday of Advent our **Pas ors'** Gospel focuses on the Visitation. After hearing that she will be the mother of

God and upon hearing that her cousin Elizabeth is in her sixth month of pregnancy, Mary decides to go and visit her to be of help during Elizabeth's final 3 months of pregnancy.

In the Visitation, we see that Mary is not concerned for herself, but for her cousin. Mary shows us that we too are called to think of others before ourselves.

When arriving at Elizabeth and Zechariah's house, the women greet each other. Then, we hear of another deeper greeting – the greeting of the two babies in the wombs of Mary and Elizabeth.

This greeting of the two human beings in the wombs (John the Baptist, who is 6 months old in the womb Elizabeth, and Our Blessed Lord who is only a few weeks old in the womb of Mary) is so real and tangible that Elizabeth feels it within herself as Mary does. This encounter will take place again about 30 years later when John the Baptist encounters his cousin Jesus at the Jordan River.

The Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth can be seen as God's way of telling us that indeed Human Life starts at conception, and that in every stage of development in the womb and outside the womb is sacred, until God calls that Human Life back to Himself. This also means that all forms of the taking of life is evil and indeed greatly sinful. Abortion, Murder, Euthanasia (MAiD) are all against the Sanctity of Life.

Let us be a people who stand up for Life in all its stages. And let us work within the political realm to ensure that all laws respect the Sanctity of Human Life from the moment of Conception until natural death.

JUBILEE YEAR 2025 - PILGRIMS OF HOPE

The Catholic Church worldwide will be celebrating a special Jubilee Year in 2025. This has been a tradition dating back to the year 1300 when Pope Boniface VIII announced the first Jubilee, also called a "Holy Year". The Jubilee Year includes many celebrations within the city of Rome and dioceses around the world. The theme of the 2025 Jubilee is "Pilgrims of Hope". In the words of Pope Francis: "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision.' The Holy Father will open the Jubilee Year on Dec 24th, with the official opening of the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica. It will continue until Jan 6, 2026, the Solemnity of the Epiphany, with the closing of the Holy Door. In the Archdiocese of Toronto, we will open the Jubilee Year with a Solemn Opening Mass taking place on Sunday, December 29th at 5 pm at St Michael's Cathedral Basilica. All are invited to join in this special celebration. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available prior to the Eucharist from 3:30 - 4:45 pm. May this Holy Year provide a grace-filled opportunity to nurture the seeds of faith for you and your loved ones, immersing ourselves as Pilgrims of Hope into a year-long journey of prayer, witness and service drawing on the example of Jesus, our Lord.


