

> ATTENTION! If you are using Envelope Box 71 and Envelope Box 74, please contact the office. We need your information (name, address, telephone, email) for our records.


2025 ENVELOPES are now available for pick-up. Boxes are not attached to any name. There is no need to look for your name and/or box number. In January, when you begin using these new

# BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY VIRTUAL TRAINING

This annual archdiocesan training will be offered online on Thursdays, February 20, 27, March 6, 13, 20, 27 from 7-8:30 pm. It is designed for new and seasoned parish bereavement ministers and will explore ways to begin a bereavement ministry in your parish or enhance your present bereavement ministry programs. Registrants are required to participate in all online sessions, complete pre-homework and pass final assessment to receive full training. There is no cost to attend but registration is required.
