Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

I don't know about you, but my spirits are

Pastors' being lifted as I see the daylight growing
longer each day. It seems like daylight brings
the spirit up and does not weigh us down as darkness does.

The theme of light and darkness is something that the Scripture writers know all too well and refer to in their canonical works. In the very beginning of the bible, in the creation account, Genesis uses light and darkness to emphasize God's work in creation and how light is seen as good and brings existence into life from the darkness. In the New Testament, light is once again seen as the good and even Jesus says, "I am the Light of the World."

As Christians, we too are lights to the world that is often living in the darkness of sin and rejection of God and his Son, Jesus Christ. We are called in our baptism to go and share our light with others.

In each Catholic church, we have an *Easter Candle* that is blessed and lit for the first time at the Easter Vigil and brought into a darkened church. This candle, which represents "*Christ our light*" is lit throughout the Easter Season and whenever we celebrate Baptisms and Funerals. What wonderful symbols we have in our church that allows us to focus on the importance of Christ: He is our guide in life and lights our path towards the Eternal Kingdom with His own very Light.

In the baptismal ceremony, a small candle is lit from our Easter Candle and is given to the person being baptized (i.e. the child or an adult in the case of an RCIA candidate at the Easter Vigil). This gesture reminds us that through our baptism we "receive the Light of Christ" and are called to illuminate our world around us.

As the days become longer, let us remember that just as the SUN brightens our world and our spirits, so too does the SON OF GOD brighten our world and our spirits. And this light of Christ is far more important to us and the whole universe than any other forms of light we encounter.

Oldest Christian symbols and was used by Christians to identify themselves and each other, often in times of persecution. It was found in the Roman catacombs. The Greek word for fish is 'Ichthus', which is also an acronym for Jesus. The Greek, 'Iesous CHristos THeou Uios Soter' translates in English to, 'Jesus Christ, Son of God, Saviour'. Christ also referred to his apostles as 'fishers of men' while the early Christian writers called the faithful 'little fish'.
