

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

On Wednesday, March 5th (Ash Wednesday) we will begin our season of Lent. For 40 days we will be able to prepare ourselves for Easter

through the Lenten Pillars of Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving.

Although we are still a week and a half before Lent begins, we should take this time and ask ourselves what we will be doing to ensure that this year's Lenten journey will be Spiritually Fruitful.

Think about what you can do in each of the Pillars of Lent. Here are some humble suggestions:

For the Pillar of PRAYER:

- Say the rosary every day during lent.
- Read a Bible passage each day before going to bed.
- ▶ Spend some time in quite reflection (i.e. about 15-30mins), thinking about the love of God for you.
- Visit a Jubilee church (in the Archdiocese) once a week. There are other suggestions, but just ensure that you are praying more than you normally do now.

For the Pillar of FASTING:

- ▶On Wednesdays and Fridays, you can Fast from your normal food intake. You can fast on bread and water those two days but ensure that this is ok with your health and doctor's advice, so that you are not causing yourself to be sick. God would not wish for you to be sick due to fasting.
- ▶ Give up something you love, or find comforting in your life such as having your coffee in the morning, or having sweets, or watching TV beyond a certain time, etc.
- ▶Add something you don't normally do now such as eating your vegetables, helping a neighbour with some tasks, read a spiritual book, etc.

For the Pillar of ALMSGIVING:

- ▶Give to ShareLife give a certain amount for every year God has given you i.e. I give \$10 for every year of life as part of my donations to ShareLife.
- ▶ Participate in the food drives we will have in our parish.
- ▶ Contribute to the local catholic agencies in Brampton that support our brothers and sisters in need i.e. St Vincent de Paul, St Louise Outreach, Knights Table, etc.

This year, please try to make a concerted effort to do something for each of the three Pillars of Lent. If you do, then at the end of our Lenten Season you will find yourself *Knowing the Lord* more and more, *Loving the Lord* more and more, and willing to *Serve the Lord* more and more.


