

 Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ, This weekend our Seminarian, Pas ors' Alessandro Sousa, will be speaking to us at all the Masses about ShareLife.

I am sure that you have heard about ShareLife, but do you know how and why it all started?

Since the foundation of the Diocese of Toronto in the 1850s, there has always been a focus on helping those who most need support. Yes, Catholic social services go back to the 1950s and continues to this day. But in 1975, the Archdiocese decided to alter its normal path of helping our brothers and sisters in need and formed what we now know as ShareLife. What happened that year to have caused this? Here is a brief but important history that I found in an article that came across my desk:

In May of 1975, the United Way of Toronto approved the admission of Planned Parenthood as a member agency. In June of that year, a meeting was held at the Chancery, outlining the position of the Council of Charities and hoping that a solution could be arrived at.

Planned Parenthood was asked to withdraw their application, on the understanding that they would be given serious consideration the following year. In February of 1976, the United Way made a decision to admit the Planned Parenthood Association of Toronto as a member agency. This organization's policy included counselling abortion as a valid choice for a pregnant woman.

To Msgr Mulvihill, and Father Paul Lennon, and our Catholic agencies, the purpose of our existence was to nurture and protect clients, and by being in an organization that supported Planned Parenthood "we would be associating with those who would eliminate one of these clients."

Less than a month later, Archbishop Pocock convened a meeting of the Council of Catholic Charities, and on March 19, the Archbishop formally announced the decision of the Council of Catholic Charities to withdraw from the United Way of Greater Toronto. So, ShareLife began with its opposition to abortion. The teaching of the Catholic Church is that life is to be protected from conception to natural death. God is the giver of life. Human beings are given this gift and have no right to intentionally end it as we choose through such evils as abortion or euthanasia. This is historical information that the faithful should be reminded about each year when the Share Life campaign is held.

As you know, one of the Pillars of Lent is *Almsgiving*. I strongly encourage you to think of giving to ShareLife. Each year, I give \$10 for every year of life that the Lord has given me. This year, I will be giving \$620 and if God wants me to continue to give until I am 100, I will try to comply with His wishes and give accordingly.

So this year, consider ShareLife when you are planning your donations of the monetary gifts you have received from the Lord. And if you are not able to give anything this year, then please give of your prayers, so that the success of this year's ShareLife campaign will be able to meet the needs of our brothers and sisters in the many agencies ShareLife supports.


