

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,
Next weekend, we enter into Holy
Week with our Palm Sunday celebrations.
During Holy Week we will be able to
out our Faith in Word and in Action. We will

live out our Faith in Word and in Action. We will commemorate the Passion, Death and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. The week will not be a normal week for us Catholics – it will be the most important week of our Liturgical Calendar.

The last three days of Holy week become the Summit of the Liturgical Year and is called the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. This single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are:

- ◆Mass of the Lord's Supper
- ◆Good Friday of the Lord's Passion
- *Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord

I hope you will be prepared to enter this Holy Week and a great way to prepare is by going to confession this week. HAPPY LENT TO ALL, Fr. Liborio
