for your understanding with the current setup. Hopefully, you are not finding it too difficult to maneuver. We should be back to normal in a few weeks.

Here is an update on the other projects the parish will be initiating in the next few months and beyond:

- ◆The *balcony railing* needs to be raised so that it meets code to ensure that the safety of our parishioners, who go to the balcony, is confirmed. This project should be completed soon, and we will pay for it from our current, regular parish funds.
- ◆We will soon have a new *outdoor Parish sign* with a screen that will enable us to better communicate our Sunday liturgies to passers by and allow us to evangelize to those who pass our parish property as well. The Knights of Columbus (K of C) and our Catholic Women's League (CWL) have graciously donated the funds needed for this important project. Hopefully, the sign will be up and running by the end of the summer.
- •We are also working with the school board to reconfigure and repave our *parking lot*. We hope to have this completed by the end of the summer, before school begins. The cost of this project will be supported by our Building and Maintenance collections. Thank you to the many of you who have so graciously contributed to this past year.
- •We will also look into renovating our *church washrooms* to create an accessible one. This is very important so that all our parishioners can feel welcome and that we meet their basic needs when they come to church.
- •Finally, in the near future, when we have the funds available, we need to work on our *parish hall*. Parishioners have asked that we improve our washrooms in the hall and expand our parish kitchen so that it will be able to meet the needs of our parish functions moving forward. Part of this scope of work may include an interior passage from the parish church to the parish hall without needing to go outside. This is a major project, but we have time, and I am sure we will move forward to ensure we have a wonderful Parish facility that we can all be proud of.


Please continue to pray for me that I may lead you all as a good shepherd to Christ who is our ALL.
