Pastors' "CHRIST IS RISEN! TRULY HE IS RISEN!"
This Sunday, and the following Sunday, we will be celebrating afternoon Masses

at 2 pm for our First Communion Children and their families. These children and families have been faithfully attending Sunday Mass since last October and have also had the opportunity to attend catechism classes in their preparation for the Sacraments. The Parish joyfully celebrates these special events of faith where our young brothers and sisters receive Jesus (His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity) in the Eucharist for the first time.

Please keep these Children and families in your prayers these next days and ask that the Lord will instill in them a desire to continue to know Him in the celebration of the Weekly Sunday Eucharist.

Do you remember when you celebrated your First Communion? If not, try to ask your family if any of them remember and who the priest was that gave you Jesus for the first time. In my case, I received my First Communion at the Martyr's Shrine in Midland. It was a Sunday afternoon in either July or August (sadly I don't know the exact date... that's my fault) when I was in grade 2 and we went to the Shrine as a family outing with my cousins and my uncle, Fr Liborio Tavares. It was this uncle and Godfather of mine that gave me my First Communion. My uncle was able to celebrate a private Mass on one of the side altars of the Shrine and it was there that I first received our Blessed Lord.

It has now been over 50 years since I first received Jesus and every time since I am still amazed that our Lord chose to be with me in such an intimate way, that He comes within us, so that we can truly say "God is within me".

I pray that all our children receiving First Communion may experience this awesomeness of being one with God every time they receive communion.

May you continue to have a blessed Easter Season and remember: "CHRIST IS RISEN! TRULY HE IS RISEN!"


