



■ Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the great Feast of Pastors' Pentecost. This is the third most important Feast of our Liturgical Celebrations (the

first is Easter and the second is Christmas).

On this feast day of Pentecost, we remember that the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity came down upon the disciples gathered in the Upper Room in Jerusalem. His indwelling enabled our early brothers and siters to leave the Upper Room with a strength and vigor that they did not have before. The Holy Spirit allowed these timid and fearful disciples to go out and proclaim the Good News without fear of anything. This Holy Spirit would ultimately provide them with the strength they would need to endure pain and suffering and to give their very lives for the cause of this Good News.

We too have received the Holy Spirit in us, through our Baptism, and in a deeper way through the Sacrament of Confirmation. Just as the disciples were strengthened to live their lives in and through Christ, so we too are given that same strength to live our lives for Christ as well.

This Feast Day of Pentecost allows us to spend time praying and reflecting on the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity. I think most of us would say that it is easier for us to reflect and pray to the first two Person's of the Blessed Trinity (i.e. the Father and the Son) than it is for the Holy Spirit. This is normal. But it should not stop us from developing a deeper and closer relationship with the Holy Spirit. He is the one who dwells in us and leads us in all graces. He is the one who ultimately allows us to proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord.

So let us spend this coming week reflecting on the Holy Spirit and how He too is Our God who lives and moves in us. HAPPY PENTECOST, Fr. Liborio
