ST PETER & ST PAUL: DID YOU KNOW? churchpop.com

St Peter: His name was originally Simon and he was a fisherman of Galilee. He was one of the 12 apostles. His brother, Andrew, introduced him to Jesus. ▶ He struggled with doubt and human weakness and yet, Jesus still chose him. St Peter was the first Pope. The Catholic Church can trace the succession of every pope back to him. The Acts of the Apostles illustrate his role as the Church's head-the rock upon which Christ would build His Church. ▶He died by crucifixion. Tradition says he requested an upside-down crucifixion because he considered himself unworthy to die the way Jesus did. Saint Peter's Basilica is built over his tomb. St Paul: Before receiving the name Paul, he was Saul, a Jewish pharisee who zealously persecuted Christians in Jerusalem. He underwent a huge conversion on his way to persecute Christians in Damascus. He instead went on to be baptized there and dedicated his life to spreading the Gospel. St Paul was imprisoned and beheaded under Emperor Nero. ▶ His letters are in the New Testament. These writings shed light on the faith of the early Church. He is buried in Rome in the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls. ▶St Paul is the patron saint of missionaries and evangelists.

As Saint Augustine said, "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labors, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith."
