

 Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Do you have a family Catholic Bible in Pasiors' your home? Do you have a personal Catholic Bible you can call your own?

If your answer is "no" to both these questions then I encourage you to do something about it.

How blessed we are to live in a time where we have access to a bible. We can now stop at a bookstore and purchase one, or we can download an app and bingo, we have the Word of God at our disposal.

Until the invention of the printing press, the bible was a rare commodity and very expensive to have, because it would be meticulously produced by scribes and monks who would spend hours and hours making a new copy of the bible. For those few parishes that had their own bible, they would often chain the bible to something and keep it secure so that it would not be taken away during the night. It was very valuable, as you could imagine. Only the very rich could afford to have a personal family bible.

We should not take for granted this grace we now have to be able to get our hands on a bible. We should all strive to have our own bibles, both in hardcopy as well as an App on our devices, such as cell phones and tablets. When we are purchasing a bible or downloading our App of the bible, we should make sure we have the Catholic Version of the bible and not a Protestant Version. And why is this important? Because the Protestant bibles do not have all the Books of the Old and New Testament that were canonically accepted as *God's Word* since the early centuries of our Church history.

There are many translations of the bible and some are very far off from the original intention of the writers. When you are thinking of purchasing a Catholic bible, I would encourage you to consider the New Revised Standard Version (NRSV), which is consider the best translation from the original Greek. This all matters because we want to ensure we are reading the bible with the best translation of the original writers.

Although many writers produced the bible we now have, written throughout many centuries – writers like Moses, the many Prophets, the Evangelists (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John), Paul and the other disciples of Christ – we believe that the AUTHOR of the entire Bible was and is God Himself.

Please ensure you have the Word of God at your fingertips and don't just have it, but read *and* pray it daily, because the bible is ultimately the story of God's interaction with humanity and all created things. God has chosen to reveal Himself through the inspired books of the bible. Ultimately the bible is GOD'S AUTOBIOGRAPHY.
