Dear Brothers and Sisters,
On January 25, 1992, I was ordained to the Diaconate and entered the first degree of ordained ministry.

In our Catholic Church we have three levels (degrees) of ordained ministry that forms the Sacrament of Holy Orders – Deacon (Diaconate), Priest (Presbyterate) and Bishop (Episcopate).

Let us ask *Google* to distinguish these three degrees:

THE THREE DEGREES:

Deacon (Diaconate): The first level, focused on service (the word *deacon* means *servant*), assisting bishops and priests, and serving the community in charity, word, and worship (e.g., baptizing, witnessing marriages, visiting the sick).

Priest (Presbyterate): Co-workers with bishops, ordained to preach, shepherd the faithful, and celebrate the sacraments, especially hearing Confessions and celebrating the Eucharist (Mass).

Bishop (Episcopate): The highest level, receiving the “fullness of the priestly ministry” to teach, govern, and sanctify the people of God, continuing the apostolic ministry.

KEY RELATIONSHIPS:

Apostolic Succession: Bishops maintain a direct lineage to the Apostles through ordination by other bishops.

Hierarchy: Priests and deacons assist the bishop in his mission, with priests sharing in Christ’s priesthood and deacons in His ministry of service.

There are also two types of Deacons – **Permanent and Transitional**. A permanent Deacon is one who is Ordained to the Diaconate and goes no farther. Almost all deacons who serve in parish across the Archdiocese of Toronto are what we call *Permanent Deacons*. This is what Deacon John is. But a Transitional Deacon is one who will be continuing towards the Presbyterate. Seminarians, like our own Alessandro, will first be ordained Transitional Deacons, and then soon after will be ordained priests.

When I was Ordained a Transitional Deacon on January 25, 1992, I was honoured to have my uncle and Godfather, Fr Liborio Tavares, vest me at this Ordination celebration. And after the Ordination, which was held at St Augustine’s Seminary (St John’s Chapel), my immediate family, grandmothers and Godfather, went to the Mandarin Restaurant on Yonge Street. I hear that they will be closing this Mandarin site, and I am thinking of going back today with my remaining immediate family, to remember and celebrate what happened 34 years ago. This will mean driving into the city, finding parking, dealing with traffic, and paying a hefty bill for all who attend, etc.

On second thought, I think I will just stay in and save my money, and gas and just celebrate on my own. ☺

Please continue to pray for me, Deacon John Coletti and our Seminarian Alessandro Sousa.
