

# March 2<sup>nd</sup> – Masses @ 9 am and 7 pm We are obliged to observe *Fasting and* Abstinence. According to the teaching of the Catholic Church: ▶ The law of Abstinence

forbids the use of meat and prohibits the eating of meat on Fridays throughout the year. > The law of Fasting allows only one full meal a day but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening. Abstinence and Fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and on the Friday of the Passion and Death of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Who are obliged to observe these precepts?

Anyone aged 14 and above are bound by the law of Abstinence. ▶ Anyone aged between 18 and 59 are obliged to Fast and Abstain. ▶ Nevertheless, Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors who are not bound by the laws of Fasting and Abstinence are educated in an authentic sense of penance.

All Fridays within the Season of Lent, there will be NO Morning Mass. In the evening at 7 pm there will be the Way of the Cross followed by Mass.

#### PLEASE REMEMBER TO FOLLOW THE NOW FAMILIAR ROUTINE:

Sanitize your hands, wear a mask, sit on indicated pews, for communion make a single line in the middle of the aisle starting from the back pews, follow the instructions of the ushers, entrance at main doors, exit at two side doors.

If you are unable or unwilling to completely follow the guidelines for masking and sanitizing, remember that Cardinal Collins continues to dispense the faithful from their Sunday obligation. If you are symptomatic, have a compromised immune system or have a greater risk of infection, please stay home.

Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday we celebrate the 8<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. The following Sunday is the beginning of Lent. This last Sunday before Lent offers us a rich array of themes that lead us right into this season of conversion and renewal.

The first reading raises the issue of speech and how what we say reveals our faults. Ben Sira advises us to withhold judgment on people until we hear what they have to say.

The Gospel calls us to self-examination. What kind of fruit are we producing in our lives? What changes are needed? This passage also reminds us not to spend our time judging the faults of others but to remove the beam from our own eyes. That is good advice at any time of the year. "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit?" A person who has admitted his/her own sinfulness is the one capable of helping someone to move forward. Only a person who looks on another with clarity of compassion has what is necessary to help the other grow.

The people who admit their limited vision and minuscule understanding of God's ways are the ones whom we can trust to orient us toward the mysteries God wants to reveal to us.

A letter from Shirley Christo to my dear Friends in Faith: I have been working with the Toronto Archdiocese and Catholic Charities to initiate the CCCB's Palliative Care Program called Horizons of Hope. We have many individuals in our churches who are living on their own in very fragile health and NEED OUR HELP. My vocational call as a Parish Nurse, since 2003, has been to try to assist these individuals and their families to obtain the Circle of Support they need.

I urgently need the assistance of two personal attendants to assist an 86-year-old female with her *Activities of Daily Living* for 3-5 hours per day. These individuals must have current CPR and First Aid and at least one must have a current or pending healthcare registration. Salary is to be negotiated.
